1. SPIER FOOD GARDEN

Since 2013, our food garden has steadily grown to provide a daily harvest of nutritious fruit, herbs, salad greens and vegetables that are sold in the Picnicky and used in kitchens across Spier. Come for a walkabout or book a self-harvesting experience.

2. SEGWAY VINEYARD TOURS

3. RIVERSIDE PICNIC AREA

Pick up your pre-booked basket or build your own picnic at the Picnicky. Then head to the Riverside picnic area – a serene spot dotted with massive granite boulders alongside our farm dam. From here, the views of the Helderberg mountains are magnificent. Being close to the river is serene and soothing.

4. WINE TASTING

Pop into the Tasting Room on the banks of our farm dam to taste our award-winning wines and delicious platters. Take time out in the airy lounge area or find a spot on the patio to enjoy the art and views of the dam and Helderberg mountains. What's not to love?

5. CRAFT MARKET

From fridge magnets to true masterpieces, Spier Craft Market offers art and craft treasures made with incredible imagination and interesting materials like mosaic, beads, textiles and ceramics. Browse a little and try your hand at designing something special with a 'make it yourself' experience, guided by a local crafter.

6. PICNICKERY

Collect your pre-ordered seasonal picnic and head out to find your perfect picnic spot. Laze under the ancient oaks on the Werf, or head to the Riverside picnic area to relax on the grassy banks of the dam, surrounded by boulders, birdsong, and glittering water.

7. THE COWSHED SHOP

Visit our new shop, where truly good goods tell stories of integrity from the heart of local communities and makers. Browse our homeware, apothecary, deli section and wine offering.

8. RIVERHOUSE

Showcasing more than 400 Creative Block artworks from both up-and-coming and established artists, the Riverhouse is all about local creativity, and hosting meetings and events like our wine blending experience. Gather together a group of friends or colleagues to put your collective winemaking skills to the test and create an original blend – then design your own unique label!

9. ELEMENTAL PLAY GARDEN

The play garden is technically for the kids, but we won't judge your adult selves for loving it too. We have divided it into quadrants representing the four elements – water, air, fire and earth – intersected by a spiralling waterway. Watch your young adventurers slide, swing, splash and crawl around this unique playground.

10. THE WERF

The Werf is Spier's historical farmyard. A beautiful place to enjoy food, family, friends and nature. Let the kids explore while you relax and enjoy good food and wine under an ancient oak.

11. THE MANOR HOUSE

Right at the very heart of Spier is The Manor House. Over 300 years old and full of history and wonder, she's been beautifully restored and reinvigorated to host small and intimate meetings and food and wine experiences. Sit amongst some of South Africa's most renowned contemporary art pieces, and marvel at the beautifully juxtaposed old and new that comes together.

12. OLD WINE CELLAR

Spier's Old Wine Cellar is South Africa's oldest dated cellar building (1767). It is currently home to rotating exhibitions of the Spier Art Collections' contemporary pieces.

13. VADAS SMOKEHOUSE AND BAKERY

All Vadas dishes use fresh, ethically and locally sourced ingredients. Cooking pasture-reared meats with fire and smoke is the main attraction but there are plenty of organic vegetarian options, freshly baked breads, pastries and Vadas's now famous pasteis de nata to choose from.

14. SPA AT SPIER

Need to remember how complete relaxation feels? Head to the spa for a day of self-care – from facials to massages.

15. SPIER HOTEL

Our hotel is currently undergoing extensive refurbishments, set to reopen in early 2025. The new 80-room hotel, restaurants, and wellness spa will offer guests an immersive place of peace, inspiration, and connection on our working wine farm.
